

**INTERIM REPORTS OF THE
OPTN/UNOS AD HOC DISEASE TRANSMISSION ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

February 9, 2012

The OPTN/UNOS Ad Hoc Disease Transmission Advisory Committee (DTAC) met via teleconference on February 9, 2012, and considered the following items.

1. The Committee reviewed twenty-one potential donor-derived disease transmission events reported to the OPTN. Three of these case reviews were led by the CDC. Tentative classifications were assigned to each.
2. Members were asked to follow along on the next case review call using the updated case classification definitions and the flow chart that helps assign classifications. Starting with review of 2012 reports, each individual organ recipient will be assigned a case classification. Minor modifications continue on the draft changes to simply the definitions and align them with definitions being used globally for classifying donor-derived disease.

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
