Introduction

The OPTN Living Donor Committee (LDC) Social Media (SoMe) Workgroup met via Citrix GoToMeeting teleconference on 10/23/2019 to discuss the following agenda items:

1. Ethics Committee Update

The Workgroup representative from the Ethics Committee gave an update on the Ethics Committee's feedback regarding the guidance document.

Summary of discussion:

The Ethics Committee offered the following feedback:

- Requested the document include reference to the Ethics Committee's 2015 whitepaper on non-directed donation.
- Suggested further data inquiry to transplant centers for their best practices.
- Without being overly prescriptive, include language that suggests transplant programs should have an approach for providing equity to patients and detail how they use social media.

Next Steps:

The Ethics Committee representative will send the 2015 Ethics Committee paper to the Workgroup for reference and inclusion in the Guidance Document.

2. Social Media Guidance Document Draft Check-In

The Workgroup reviewed the sections of the guidance document that still need volunteers.

Next steps:

Workgroup members are encouraged to volunteer to draft narrative for sections of the guidance document prior to the next meeting.

3. Project Timeline Review

The Workgroup reviewed the project timeline and subsequent deadlines.

The Living Donor Committee will review the draft of the guidance document at the in-person Chicago meeting on October 28. The draft will then go for internal review in late November and the Living Donor Committee will vote on the final document to go to Public Comment on December 11.
