# OPTN Minority Affairs Committee Meeting Summary November 20, 2023 Conference Call

#### Introduction

The OPTN Minority Affairs Committee (the Committee) met via Webex teleconference on 11/20/2023 to discuss the following agenda items:

- 1. Monitoring Report Presentation: 6 Month Waiting Time Modification/ 1 Year Race-Neutral eGFR Calculations
- 2. New Project Idea: Race Neutral Requirement for OPTN Policy

The following is a summary of the Committee's discussions.

1. Monitoring Report Presentation: 6 Month Waiting Time Modification/ 1 Year Race- Neutral eGFR Calculations

The Committee heard an update on the 1-year monitoring report for <u>Establish OPTN Requirements for</u> <u>Race-Neutral eGFR Calculations</u> that was implemented on July 27, 2022. The purpose of the race-neutral estimated glomerular filtration rate (eGFR) calculation policy was to prohibit the use of the eGFR calculation that included a race-based variable in OPTN Policy. This requirement for a race-neutral calculation was intended to increase equity in access to transplantation for Black kidney candidates.

The Committee also heard an update on the 6-month monitoring report for <u>Modify Waiting Time for</u> <u>Candidates Affected by Race-Inclusive eGFR Calculations</u> that was implemented on January 5, 2023. This policy provides a pathway for waiting time modifications for Black kidney candidates who were affected by a race-inclusive eGFR calculation. This policy requires programs to review their waiting lists and request eGFR waiting time modifications for registered Black kidney candidates impacted by a raceinclusive eGFR calculation.

#### Data summary:

**Race-Neutral eGFR Calculations** 

- There were no large changes to the kidney waiting list or to the transplant recipientdistributions were similar across the eras.
- There was a decrease of candidates qualifying for waiting time by maintenance dialysis and a corresponding increase in those qualifying as of tiebreaker (registration) date. This suggests a shift to candidates using lab values, such as eGFR, to qualify for waiting time over maintenance dialysis.

Modifications and Attestations

- 6103 processed eGFR waiting time modifications with a median of 1.7 years given to modified registrations.
- 491 candidates with a waiting time modification received a deceased donor transplant, and 15 received a living donor transplant.

As of July 5, 2023, the OPTN received attestations received from 12 of the 232 active kidney programs.

#### Summary of discussion:

This was not an agenda item that required a decision; no decisions were made by the Committee.

A member asked if the monitoring report would be published for the public. The presenter replied that the monitoring report would be posted on the OPTN website, and a news item would be released to inform the community. A member inquired if there was an avenue for patients to share their testimonials about their experience receiving a transplant as a result of these policy changes. The presenter replied that this can be discussed with the communications team to determine other ways to highlight patient stories.

## 2. New Project Idea: Race Neutral Requirement for OPTN Policy

The Committee continued their discussion on new project ideas. Staff proposed a new project to require all calculations and tests used for the OPTN to be race-neutral. This project would involve identifying any other tests and calculations in OPTN Policy that would allow the inclusion of a race variable and assessing the extent of adjustment the community would be required to shift to race neutral methods.

#### Summary of discussion:

This was not an agenda item that required a decision; no decisions were made by the Committee.

There was consensus among members that removing race from all calculations and tests that the OPTN uses should be done. A member stated that the Committee should move forward with removing race in OPTN policies in organ transplantation.

#### Next steps:

The Committee will determine whether they would like to move forward with the new project idea.
