

2024 Donation and Transplant Trends

- More than 41,000 transplants from deceased donors
- More than 7,000 transplants from living donors
- 10.4% more lung transplants than in 2023 3,340 total
- 7,280 DCD donors 23.5% increase from 2023



HOPE Act Update

- November 2024: HHS issued final rule to remove clinical research requirements for kidney, liver and liver-kidney transplants performed with donors living with HIV and recipients living with HIV.
- HHS directed the OPTN to develop new policy and standards of care to enable the final rule.
- Once in effect, the OPTN will update OPTN member institutions.



Data Directive Update

- February 2024: HRSA issued secretarial directive for the OPTN to collect data on:
 - Patients prior to being added to the waitlist
 - Ventilated patients being referred to an OPO
- November 4, 2024 January 3, 2025: Federal Register publication; 60-day public comment
- December 13, 2024: OPTN submitted its response
- Next: HRSA reviewing; another 30-day public comment period will open before the directive is finalized

18-Month Monitoring Report: CD Lung



- 26.3% decrease in waitlist mortality rate
- 28.9% increase in transplant rate
- Utilization rate remained stable at 18%
- Patient 6-month post-transplant survival remained stable at 93.2%
